Petworth House and Park

Petworth House and Park is a beautiful 17th Century mansion set in parkland designed by Lancelot 'Capability' Brown, and is nestled in the South Downs National Park in England. It houses the finest art collection in the care of the National Trust



In the afternoon we shall be driving into **Petworth village** where you will have the opportunity to explore the picturesque streets and tea shops.

As an optional extra you may wish to visit the **Petworth Cottage Museum** that features an insight into the lives of past estate workers. The museum is furnished as it would have been about 1910. There you will receive an introductory talk, enjoy a wander around the exhibits followed by a Q&A. **The extra cost for this is £4 and must be reserved with your booking**



In the Servants' Quarters, you will see an exhibition of paintings of the winner of the Sky Landscape Artist of the Year 2016 whose work is inspired by the Petworth landscape
